While most wells take water out of the ground, this one pumped more than 750 million gallons into **our community's water reserves** last year. For more than a decade, the Southern Nevada Water Authority has been pumping Colorado River water into the ground beneath the Las Vegas Valley to **ensure our water supply remains reliable.**

But reserves alone aren't the answer. Like your savings account, **the idea is to avoid making withdrawals until absolutely necessary.** This is where you come in. By following the SNWA's watering schedule and other water-saving measures, you are helping us stretch our current water supply and maintain these reserves.
