PROJECT SCOPE:

The project is located in White Pine and Lincoln County, Nevada (Hydrographic Basin No. 184), as indicated on the Drawings.

The proposed Work is generally described as follows:

The Project comprises drilling and completing six monitor wells and one piezometer well to various depths and the sampling of 16 wells in White Pine and Lincoln County, Nevada (See Appendix A, for maps of the proposed Well and Sample Sites). The Work Sites are located in Spring Valley (Hydrographic Basin No. 184). The monitor wells are to be drilled using rotary drilling methods and completed with one 12-inch and five 4-inch completion strings. The piezometer well is to be drilled using a gas powered auger and completed with a 2-inch completion string. Temporary conductor casings for the monitor wells are at the discretion of the contractor. Upon completion of work at each Site, the Site shall be restored to as near natural condition as possible.

The Work is a public works project as defined by Chapter 338 of the Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) and all Bidders are required to comply with, and the Contract shall be awarded and administered in accordance with, the laws contained in that chapter.

PREBID CONFERENCE: A prebid conference and site tour will be held beginning at 8:00a.m. on September 8, 2010 at the Copper Queen/Ramada Inn in Ely, NV 89301 and will proceed from Ely to Spring Valley.

BID OPENING: September 22, 2010 at 10:15 a.m. in the Las Vegas Valley Water District, 1001 S. Valley View Blvd., Las Vegas, Nevada, 89107, Mead Conference Room.

PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS: Bidding Documents may be obtained from the Purchasing Office of the Las Vegas Valley Water District, 1001 South Valley View Boulevard, Las Vegas, Nevada, (702) 258-3200. A complete set of Bidding Documents includes Bidding and General Requirements, Technical Specifications and Drawings may be purchased for the non-refundable cost of \$25.00. Payment by check must be received at the Purchasing Office payable to the "Las Vegas Valley Water District". Instead of a delivery charge, mailing may be expedited by providing with the payment, the express mail carrier with account number to be charged. If mailing of the Bidding Documents via United Parcel ground is desired, an additional charge of \$20.00 is required.

Bid Security in the amount of 5% of the Bid Price must accompany each Bid.

Pursuant to Nevada Revised Statute 338.143, the AUTHORITY reserves the right to reject any or all Bids, including, without limitation, the right to reject any or all nonconforming, nonresponsive, unbalanced, or conditional Bids, and to reject the Bid of any Bidder if AUTHORITY believes that it would not be in the best interest of AUTHORITY to make an award to that Bidder. AUTHORITY also reserves the right to waive informalities. Bids will be evaluated as prescribed in NRS 338.147.
