PROJECT SCOPE:

The Lower Narrows and Homestead Weirs are located in the Las Vegas Wash, Clark County, Nevada.

The proposed Work is generally described as follows:

The Project comprises clearing, site preparation, excavation, dewatering, construction of riprap lined banks, two riprap erosion control weirs, and storm drain facilities on the Las Vegas Wash floodplain.

The Work is a public works project as defined by Chapter 338 of the Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) and all Bidders are required to comply with, and the Contract shall be awarded and administered in accordance with, the laws contained in that chapter.

Payment by check must be received at the Purchasing Office payable to the "Las Vegas Valley Water District". Instead of a delivery charge, mailing may be expedited by providing with the payment, the express mail carrier with account number to be charged. If mailing of the Bidding Documents via United Parcel ground is desired, an additional charge of \$20.00 is required.

Bid Security in the amount of 5% of the Bid Price must accompany each Bid.

AUTHORITY also reserves the right to waive informalities. Bids will be evaluated as prescribed in NRS 338.147.
